Harvey is considered a world leader on monthly giving. He has written two books *Hidden Gold* and his latest book *How to Create Lifelong Donors Through Monthly Giving*, released in 2020.

He is a highly rated trainer and has taught fundraising to thousands of non-profit staff. A frequent speaker at conferences including: the AFP International (where he was tied for the highest rated out of over 100 speakers).
